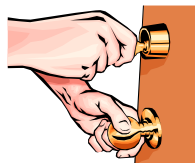

Locked Out...

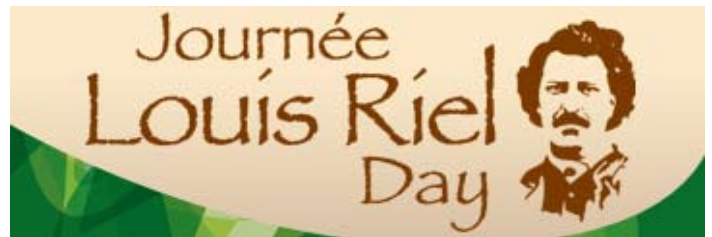
You have to have a key to lock your suite making it virtually impossible to be locked out. If you become locked out during the week Mon-Fri- 8am-6pm - contact the Caretaker if available and they will unlock your suite door and let you in. Tenants will have to come to WHRC office to get new keys and be charged accordingly.

Replacement Keys:

- Front Door - (Medico Lock or Key Fob) - \$20.00
- Suite Key - \$5.00
- Mailbox Key - \$5.00
- New Mailbox Lock/key- \$25.00
- New Suite Entry Dead bolt - \$50.00



AFTER HOURS LOCK-OUT - Make sure all family members have keys because if you are locked out after hours you will have to call a locksmith as neither WHRC or the Caretaker will be available to open your suite door.

WHRC recently installed security cameras and a new door entry system at **435 Sargent Avenue**. As well, cameras were installed at **Flora Place**. The installation is an effort to keep our housing safe and secure. The new

system has been a welcome addition and is already providing positive results.

Not only will the buildings have video surveillance but will also offer an extra level of security with the door entry system. Each tenant will receive a fob or device that resembles a key chain. The device is used to open the door without the use of a key. Tenants will no longer need keys to enter the building, so remember to smile, because you are being watched.
