REQUEST FOR REPAIRS

Please contact your caretaker to report all maintenance problems. Issues such as leaky taps, toilet issues, lighting, and beeping smoke detectors should be reported to your caretaker immediately. If the caretaker is unable to fix the problem they will tell WHRC's maintenance department and a contractor will be called.



EMERGENCY REPAIRS

Tenants may use the after hours emergency line (949-2880) for EMERGENCIES only. After 5:00 pm weekdays and on weekends". These would include: Loss of power, loss of heat, burst water pipes, flooding, sewer back-up, and electrical issues that threaten your personal safety or the safety of the building.

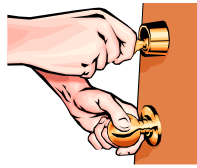

After office hours you need to call a locksmith to get in.



Chicken Adobo Recipe (Philippines)

1 cup vinegar
2 heads crushed garlic
1/2 tsp black pepper
1 bay leaf
2 tbsp soy sauce
1 chicken, cut up
1 1/2 cups water
1 tbsp cooking oil



In a saucepan, combine vinegar, garlic, pepper, bay leaf, salt and soy sauce. Put in chicken. Let soak for 20 to 30 minutes. Add water and simmer uncovered until tender. Strain sauce. Set aside. Brown garlic and chicken in cooking oil. Return everything to saucepan, cover and simmer until sauce thickens.
